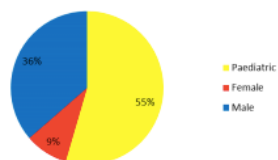
We look forward to working with them offering our valuable service of medical advice.



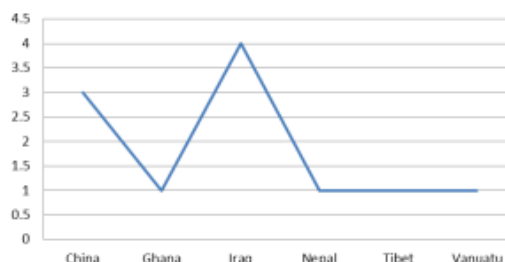
